Students can apply for an exemption from Swiss health insurance if their home health insurance confirms that they offer the same coverage as a Swiss health insurance and agree to cover all possible costs. If the student's home health insurance provider refuses to sign the required document, a Swiss health insurance, e.g. Swisscare needs to be purchased.
