	native speakers of the respective language, are	
	expected to have a standard of proficiency at the level	
	of C1 of the CEFR in the respective language.

Language Courses	Students can participate in an intensive German course for a fee of CHF 120 that takes place two weeks before the beginning of the semester. Other language courses are offered during the semester, which cost between CHF 80 and CHF 150 depending on the chosen course and amount of weekly lessons.
