# **Language Proficiency Requirements**

For English-taught programs, the suggested English proficiency is B2, TOEFL IBT 72, IELTS 5.5, TOEIC 750 or equivalent. Students who take an English-program at home university are exempt from this requirement.

For Chinese-taught programs, the suggested Chinese proficiency are <u>TOCFL</u> Level 2 (A2) or <u>HSK</u> Level 4.

# **GPA Requirement**

2.5/4.0 or above.

#### Credit per Course

1-3 credits; 16-18 hours for 1 credit.

# **Chinese Language Course**

CGU offers complimentary Chinese language courses for all international students during the semester.

#### **Tuition and Miscellaneous fees**

- According to the student exchange agreement, exchange students pay tuition and fees to their home universities.
- Exchange students to CGU are required to purchase Health and Accident insurance (covering NT\$1,000,000, approx. US\$36,000) in home country or in Taiwan, which covers the entire period of the stay in CGU and in Taiwan. Proof of Health and Accident insurance is required upon registration. - Optional: upon registration at CGU, students may choose to be part of the Student Safety Insurance, the fee is NT\$200-300 per semester.
