Language Proficiency Requirements

For English-taught programs, the suggested English proficiency is TOEIC 600 or equivalent. Students who take an English-program at home university are exempt from this requirement.

For Chinese-taught programs, the suggested Chinese proficiency are TOCFL Level 2 (A2) or HSK Level 4.

GPA Requirement

2.5/4.0 or above.

Credit per Course

1-3 credits; 16-18 hours for 1 credit.

CGU offers complimentary Chinese language courses for all international students during the semester.

Tuition and Miscellaneous fees

- According to the student exchange agreement, exchange students pay tuition and fees to their home universities.
- Exchange students to CGU are required to purchase Health and Accident insurance (covering NT\$1,000,000, approx. US\$36,000) in home country or in Taiwan, which covers the entire period of the stay in CGU and in Taiwan. Proof of Health and Accident insurance is required upon registration. Proof of Health and Accident insurance is required upon registration.
- Optional: upon registration at CGU, exchange students are encouraged to join CGU's student safety insurance. The fee is approximately NT\$200-300 per semester.

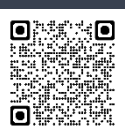
