| 8 Language & GPA Requirement | Language Proficiency: Applicants must demonstrate English or Chinese language proficiency with one of the following minimum scores: TOEFL iBT 64 , IELTS 5.0, TOEIC 700, HSK Level 4 Alternatively, proof of proficiency at the CEFR B1 level or above is acceptable. Applicants who hold nationality from an English-speaking country are exempt from submitting an official English test score. Academic Requirement: Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. |

Exchange students are not able to enroll in the courses delivered in-service master's program and Dual Degree Program.Whether exchange students can enroll in a course will be determined by the instructor after the semester begins. 2. Free Mandarin Learning courses (reading, listening, conversation, and writing courses) provided. |
