1) Room & Fee (not including meals)	Re-Cheng Dorm (4 people per room) : NT\$ 16,500 / per person/ per semester.

<b>7 Medical Check</b>	Medical check (for Form C, <a href="https://www.cdc.gov.tw/File/Get/-RtSRStyQJvTWtoMo65JTg">https://www.cdc.gov.tw/File/Get/-RtSRStyQJvTWtoMo65JTg</a> ) will be arranged after students arrive in Taiwan at a cost of NT\$1000-1500 if it cannot be completed in your home country. Form C: Health Certificate for Short-Term Students (one semesters students): Chest X-ray for Tuberculosis and Proof of Positive Measles and Rubella-Antibody or Measles and Rubella Vaccination Certificate.
<b>8 Language &amp; GPA Requirement</b>	1. TOEFL IBT 64 or IELTS 5 or TOEIC 700 or HSK4. (We do not require an official English test score if the student has nationality from an Anglophone country) 2. <b>GPA 2.5/4.0</b>
<b>9 Visa Application Fee and Information</b>	OIA will assist students who have Visitor visa (60 or 90 days) to extend visa before the visa expired date in Taiwan.

2) Introduction	Mandarin Learning Center at CYCU that is responsible for offering various Mandarin courses which provide long-term Mandarin courses, one-on-one courses, and short-term Mandarin camps. Both one-on-one course and short-term camps can be customized according to your specific needs. Mandarin Learning Center offer both online and in-person course options.

2) Other Informaion	1. Inbound exchange students are required to complete 6 credits min. to 25 credits max (undergraduate students); 3 credits min. to 25 credits max (Graduate or Ph.D. students). Exchange students are not able to enroll in the courses delivered in-service master's program and Dual Degree Program. Whether exchange students can enroll in a course will be determined by the instructor after the semester begins. 2. Free Mandarin Learning courses (reading, listening, conversation, and writing courses) provided.
<b>12 Official Chapel Class or Church Near the School</b>	We have a chapel on campus; a baptist church and an interdenominational church next to the campus.
<b>13 Other Programs for Exchange Student</b>	Cultural Trip and other activites for international students.
<b>14 On Campus Facilities</b>	Starbucks, MacDonald, Post Office, Library, etc.
<b>15 Facilities Around the School (e.g., Supermarket, bank...)</b>	Restaurant, Night Market, Bank, Supermarket, Coffee shops, Beauty shop, hospital, etc.
<b>16 Weather</b>	Mar. to May : 20-25°C; Jun. to Aug. 27-35°C; Sep. to Nov. 20-28°C; Dec. to Feb. 10-22°C. (averagely) In Taiwan, we don't have heating at home or in school. Therefore, we suggest students to bring warm clothes during SPRING semester.
<b>17 Other Information</b>	Mattress pads, blankets, pillow, toiletries, cloth washing powder, etc., can be purchased locally, at an expense of about NT\$10,000.
