Inbound exchange students are required to complete 6 credits min. to 25 credits max (undergraduate students); 3 credits min. to 25 credits max (Graduate or Ph.D. students). Exchange students are not able to enroll in the courses delivered in-service master's program and Dual Degree Program. Whether exchange students can enroll in a course will be determined by the instructor after the semester begins. 2. Free Mandarin Learning courses (reading, listening, conversation, and writing courses) provided.</p>
17	<b>Official Chapel Class or Church Near the School</b> We have a chapel on campus; a baptist church and an interdenominational church next to the campus.
