<b>6 Insurance</b>	- one-semester students: purchase in home country or in CYCU. (Medical and Travel Insurance) - two-semester students: purchase in home country and NHI (National Health Insurance) in Taiwan 6 months later (This is compulsory) (However, if students leave Taiwan over 30 days, the six months need to be recalculated)
<b>7 Medical Check</b>	- should be completed before coming to Taiwan. 1. Form B (two semesters students): Chest X-ray for Tuberculosis, Stool examination for parasites includes Entamoeba histolytica etc., Serological Test for Syphilis and Proof of Positive Measles and Rubella-Antibody or Measles and Rubella Vaccination Certificate. 2. Form C (one semesters students): Chest X-ray for Tuberculosis and Proof of Positive Measles and Rubella-Antibody or Measles and Rubella Vaccination Certificate.B34
