	The National Taiwan University of Science and Technology (Taiwan Tech) was founded on August 1, 1974, as the National Taiwan Institute of Technology. It was the first higher education institution of its kind within our nation's technical and vocational education system.

Taiwan Tech has five campuses: the main Taipei campus and branch campuses at Tu-Cheng, Keelung, Gong-Guan and Chupei, with a combined total area of 29.44 hectares.
