1. Term Dates & Deadlines

2. Nomination

Nomination needs to be filled out by exchange coordinators before the above deadlines in our portal. An invitation will be provided in March (Fall & One Year) / August (Spring). **(No GPA or English proficiency certificate required)**

3. Application Process

Nominated students will receive a welcome letter after being nominated and they have to complete our on-line application by the above deadlines.

Required materials to be uploaded are,

- (1) Copy of passport
- (2) Passport-sized photo
- (3) CV



4. Orientation

The orientation will be one week before the semester starts and it's compulsory.

- **Fall 2025: 2025.08.27**
- **Spring 2026: 2026.02.23**

5. Housing

- (1) i-House – 5 mins walking distance from the NCCU campus (single room or double room): USD 1,300-1,800 / semester (4.5 months) – **through online application** by May 1
 - (2) Outside-campus accommodation: around USD400-700 / month / suite
 - (3) On-campus dormitory: double room and multiple rooms: USD 400-800 / semester (4.5 months) – **by request** (please send an email **by May 1 for Fall / November 1 for Spring** to crhuang@nccu.edu.tw) as most students are not able to accept living in shared rooms.
*located in uphill campus – 20 mins by walk or 5 mins by shuttle to downhill campus.

7. Credits

At NCCU, 3 credits = 48 hours of in-class teaching hours. Normally, NCCU local students will take 15-20 credits (undergraduate), 9-15 for graduate, and the average credit number for exchange students is 12, in one semester.

8. Buddy Program

We will assign local Taiwanese voluntary students to assist exchange students in any problems they may encounter, to help them adjust to the life in Taipei.

9. Grading

The academic assessment methods on exchange students are frequently in the forms of class participation, attendance, examinations, quizzes, projects, assignments, case studies, and presentations for each individual course. We maintain a 100-point grading scale system as below:

10. Visa

- (1) Staying less than 180 days (For students who will stay for one semester):**
- ✧ It's required to apply for a visa while the purpose is study.
 - ✧ If you have plans to travel around, applying for a **Multiple Visa** will be better.
 - ✧ If there is no plan to go abroad when studying in Taiwan, a **Single Visa** is sufficient that the NCCU will provide the immigration documents for visa extension to at most 6 months for free. **Please be notified that it is NOT possible to change a Single Visa to a Multiple one in Taiwan.**
- (2) Staying more than 180 days (For students who will study for one academic year):**
- ✧ Please apply for a **Resident Visa**. Within 15 days upon the first arrival in Taiwan, please apply for an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) in the National Immigration Agency. An immigration package will be provided by NCCU for obtaining your ARC.
- (3) Please review the visa application details in Taiwan Mission Office in your country.**

- (5) For students who hold a Chinese passport, NCCU will need to apply for the Entry Permit for you. Instructions will be provided individually.**

11. Insurance

Students have to prepare their own medical insurance before coming to Taiwan, as there is no medical insurance product provided by NCCU. In the meantime, kindly note that all exchange students are required to purchase a basic student accident insurance provided by NCCU (NTD 250 – around USD 8) during their stay in Taiwan.
