However, being able to use either English or Chinese to communicate and take courses is necessary. *Most of the courses taught in English at NCU are in graduate level but allow junior and senior undergraduate to take. Therefore, an undergraduate student

	without Chinese Proficiency but with good English Proficiency should come to NCU for exchange on the 3 rd year or 4 th year of their undergraduate.
