VISA

For ONE SEMESTER exchange students,

Please apply for the **Visitor Visa** for 60 or 90 Days Entry as a foreign student.

For extension of visa, you may apply the visa after arrival or go abroad in the middle of the semester. Further details will be instructed at Orientation.

For ONE YEAR exchange/ Dual Degree students,

Please apply for the **Resident Visa** in order to apply for the Alien Resident Card (A.R.C.) within 15 days upon your arrival.



VISA Waive Policy **DOES NOT APPLY** to students coming for study. All students **MUST** obtain a VISTOR VISA in order to study in Taiwan.



Academic Requirements

The following three courses are mandatory for all International Exchange and Dual Degree Students:

- Basic Chinese (2 credits)
- Beginning Chinese (2 credits)
- Chinese Culture and Communication (2 credits)

Credits

- Undergraduate Students: minimum 9 credits, maximum 25 credits.
- Graduate Students: minimum 6 credits.

(The instruction of course selection will be instructed at Orientation. Please bring your laptop to Orientation.)



Health Exam

For ONE SEMESTER exchange students,

For ONE YEAR exchange/ Dual Degree students,

Please refer to the Health Check Certificate for Residence Application.

1. Health Exam can be carried out at your country or upon your arrival
2. There will be a health exam arranged by USC. Certain fees will be charged (approximately NTD 1,000 ~ NTD 2,000).
3. Vaccination in Taiwan will be requested if your vaccination certificate is not available.

** The original certificate must be in English or Chinese authenticated by an R.O.C. representative office in the country where the certificate is issued.*
