Chinese Language Courses (if applicable)	We offer free 4 credits Chinese language courses for exchange students. (from Beginning to Intermediate) Students will need to do level check if they intend to take the course. If students are beginners, they do not need to take the level check and will be arranged in the beginners class. Accommodation	Students may choose to stay either on/off-campus dorm or rent a studio themselves. Buddy Program	We provide Buddy Program service where every exchange student will be paired with at least 1 SU volunteer student. The volunteer students will help exchange students with matters related to studies and daily life, including airport pick-up, assistance in checking in accommodation, courses registration and the other administrative process, help to adjust to the campus life, including transportation, dining map, medical treatment, etc. There is no need for exchange students to sign up for this program as Center for Global Engagement will automatically assign every accepted exchange student a SU volunteer. The contact information of new coming exchange students will be forwarded to the corresponding volunteer students before the semester begins.
