## 1 Introduction

### Welcome to International School of Management (ISM) at University of the Thai Chamber of Commerce (UTCC)

UTCC is the **first** private non-profit higher education institution in Thailand. It offers degrees in Business Administration, Accounting, Economics, Humanities, Science, Communication Arts, Engineering, Law, **Early Childhood Education, Tourism and Services, Digital Art and Design, and Nursing.**

It is a place where academic theories and business experiences are integrated, to produce graduates who can successfully meet the challenges facing today's global business.

"UTCC International College" was founded in **2010**. As it grows with the time and widens the scope of its operations, in **August 2019**, the university decided to change the name to **UTCC – International School of Management (iSM)**. The iSM runs International Programs purely taught in English both at Undergraduate and Postgraduate Levels.

**From Suvarnabhumi Airport:** You can take the airport link to Makkasan Station and change to MRT Phetchaburi, then get off at the MRT Huai Khwang Station (Exit 3). Alternatively, you can take a taxi directly from the airport to UTCC.

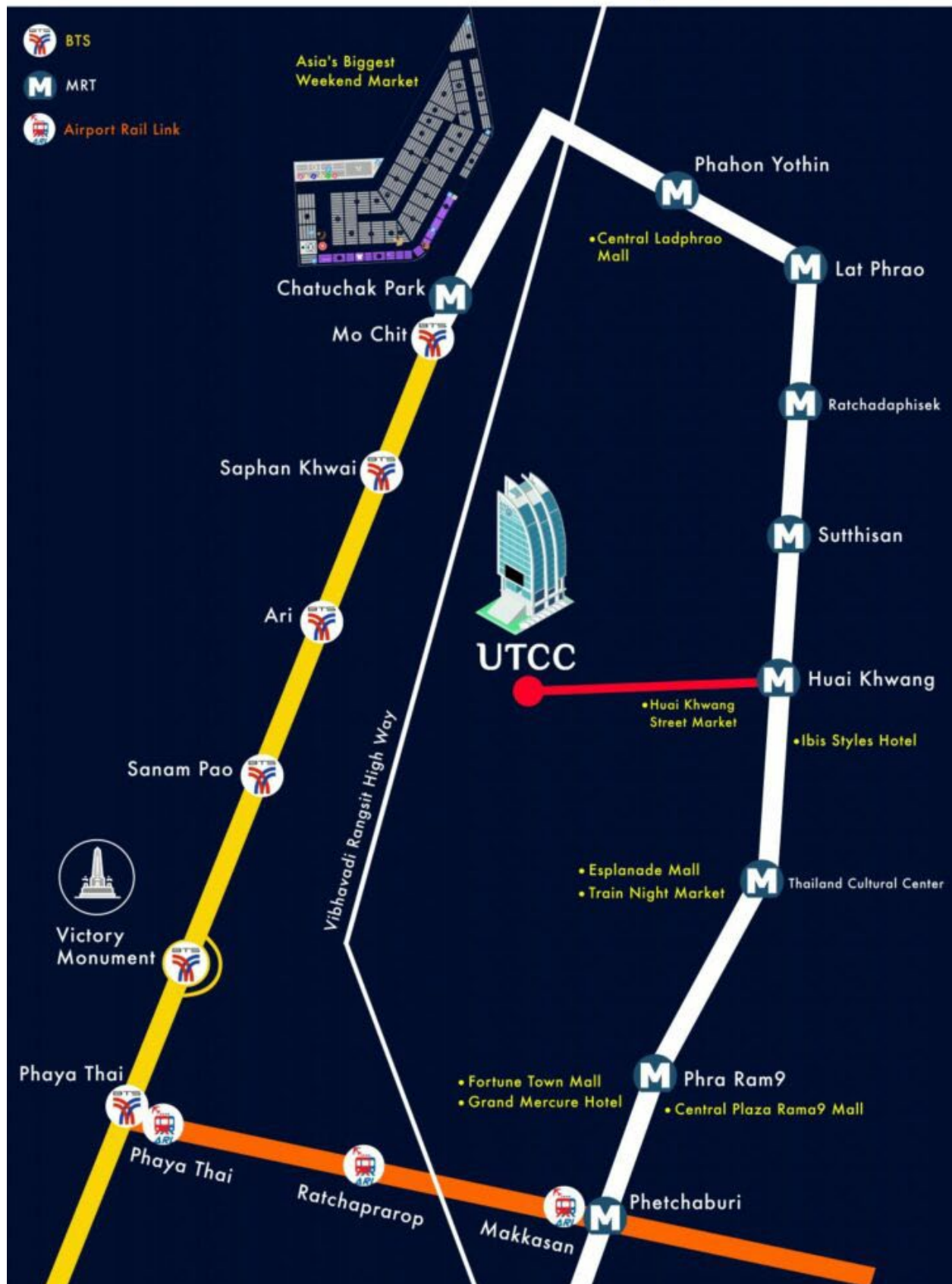
**From Don Muang Airport:** You can take the Airport Bus A1, get off at the MRT Chatuchak station, and then take the MRT to Huai Khwang Station (Exit 3). Alternatively, you can take a taxi directly from the airport to UTCC. Or you can take the SRT Red Line and get off at Krungthep Aphiwat Grand Station to connect to MRT Blue Line.

\*Overall, depending on the student's lifestyle and desires, THB 30,000 per month should be more than enough to cover living costs, plus extra travel and pocket money.

## 4 Class Absences and Exam Procedures

### 4.1 Class Absences

**Students are not allowed to have more than three absences per subject per semester.**

Without valid reason, if a student has more than three absences the student will not have the right to sit the midterm and final exams, resulting in an “F” or FAIL in that subject.

### 4.2 Exam Rules

1. On the day of an exam, students must wear proper uniform (White Shirt and black trousers/skirt)
2. Students are required to bring their Student ID card to all exams.
3. Students who miss the final exams will automatically receive an F grade.
4. Students must be in the exam room no later than 30 minutes before the start of an exam or it will count as an absence and will result in an automatic “F” (Fail)
5. If a student is caught cheating the student will be automatically FAILED in the subject with a suspension as a penalty

## 5 Visa Information

**Students are officially required to apply for a Non-Immigrant ED Visa for study purposes as the priority option, according to immigration rules in Thailand.**

### 5.1 Getting your Visa:

#### 5.1.1 Non-Immigrant ED Visa

Once a student registers (online) to study at UTCC, UTCC is responsible for providing all the necessary documents (send via e-mail) to apply for a Non-Immigrant ED Visa at the Royal Thai Embassy or Thai Consulate overseas.

#### 5.1.2 Tourist Visa (60-day valid) or Exemption Visa (30-day valid at least is required.)

A Tourist Visa (valid for 60 days) or an Exemption Visa (valid for at least 30 days) may also be used if the Non-Immigrant ED Visa is not available or has been denied.

Following this information, a Tourist Visa or an Exemption Visa needs to be converted into a Non-Immigrant ED in Thailand. Students are requested to contact the UTCC Office of International Relations, located in building 21, 7th floor, to meet with Ms. Tran Thi Minh Uyen, room 21714, or Ms. Sirikwan P., room 21709, upon arrival in Thailand within a week to receive assistance in preparing

the required documents.

**Documents required for the visa application:**

1. Passport
2. UTCC tuition fee receipt
3. Latest degree certificate in English translation
4. TM.30 the Notification of Residence
5. E-Visa approval letter (If any)
6. One 2-inch colored photo (Formal picture without wearing glasses)

**Remark:** There is a THB 2,000 fee in cash; the student is responsible to apply in person for their visa at the Immigration Bureau, Chaeng Watthana.

## **5.2 Visa Extension**

A Non-Immigrant ED Visa is 90 days valid. The expiration date is set upon arrival in Thailand, and it is clearly mentioned in the arrival stamp of the passport. This visa is required to be extended 45 days before it expires, according to the immigration rule. UTCC is responsible for supporting students in preparing the necessary documents. Following the information, students are required to contact UTCC at the Office of International Relations, building 21, 7<sup>th</sup> floor, to meet with Ms. Tran Thi Minh Uyen, room 21714, or Ms. Sirikwan P., room 21709, upon arrival in Thailand within a week to get assistance in preparing the required documents.

**Documents required for the visa extension:**

1. Passport
2. UTCC tuition fee receipt
3. TM.30 the Notification of Residence
4. E-Visa approval letter (If any)
5. One 2-inch colored photo (Formal picture without wearing glasses)

**Remark:** There is a THB 1,900 fee in cash; It is the person responsible for applying for the visa at the Immigration Bureau, Chaeng Watthana.

## **5.3 “90-Day Notification”**

Students who hold A Non-Immigrant ED Visa are required to report for the 90-Day Notification if they stay longer than 90 days in Thailand. Please carefully note that a Non-Immigrant ED visa and the 90-Day Notification are completely separate. The 90-Day Notification is set when students have completed the first-time visa extension at the Immigration Bureau, Chaeng Watthana. The 90-Day Notification can be applied 15 days in advance or 7 days after the appointment date.

In case students have left Thailand before the appointment date. It will be reset and recounted upon arrival in Thailand. This is a personal responsibility; there is no requirement for the UTCC letter on this matter, and a fine of THB 2,000 is charged when reporting is ignored.

Documents required for the 90-Day Notification:

1. Passport (No requirement for a photocopy)
2. Completed application form for TM. 47 (This form is available at the Immigration Bureau, Chaeng Watthana)

Remark: Free of charge on this matter

## 5.4 Re-Entry Permit

A Re-Entry Permit is a requirement for students before leaving the country every single time while living in Thailand with a regular Non-Immigrant ED Visa (for a short-term program student). **\*\* A Non-Immigrant ED Plus Visa is a Re-Entry Permit exemption, which is for a long-term program. Kindly ignore this matter.**

2 Types of Re-Entry Permit application:

- Single Entry Permit: Suitable for a single time. (Fee of THB 1,000)
- Multiple Entry Permit: Suitable for travelling multiple times. (Fee of THB 3,800) \*\* This is strongly recommending students who intend to travel more than 4 times during the visa expiration period.

Remark: A Re-Entry Permit validity date is retained to the visa expiration date.

**\*\*Following the information, the application is available either at the Immigration Bureau, Chaeng Watthana in advance or at the immigration airport on the departure day.**

Documents required for the Re-Entry Permit:

1. Passport (Photocopy is required)
2. Completed application form for TM. 8 (This form is available at the Immigration Bureau, Chaeng Watthana)
3. One 2-inch colored photo (Formal picture without wearing glasses)

## 5.5 Notification of Residence (TM.30)

This is important for all foreign students when staying in Thailand. The landlords are required to register their residential address with the Immigration Bureau, Chaeng Watthana, within 24 hours of the foreigner's arrival. Ensure to acknowledge them, as it is necessary for the visa matters each time.

### Documents required for the Notification of Residence TM.30

Option 1: The landlord personally applies to the immigration office (all documents are required for a photocopy.)

1. Completed application form for TM. 30

2. Passport of the residential
3. Rental contract of the residential
4. House registration of the owner
5. Passport or citizen ID card of the owner

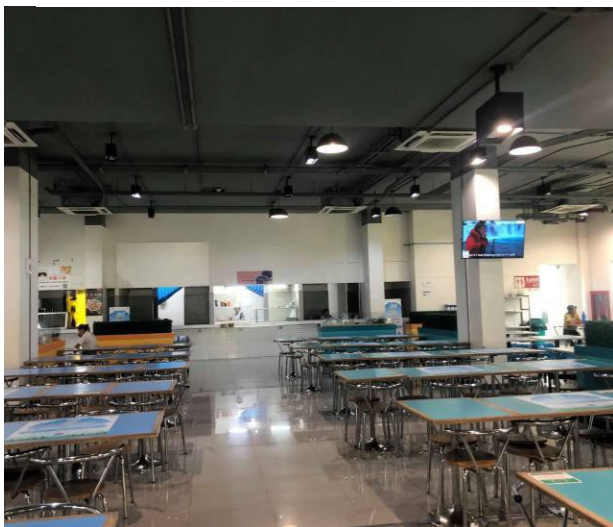
## 7 Where to find Food?
