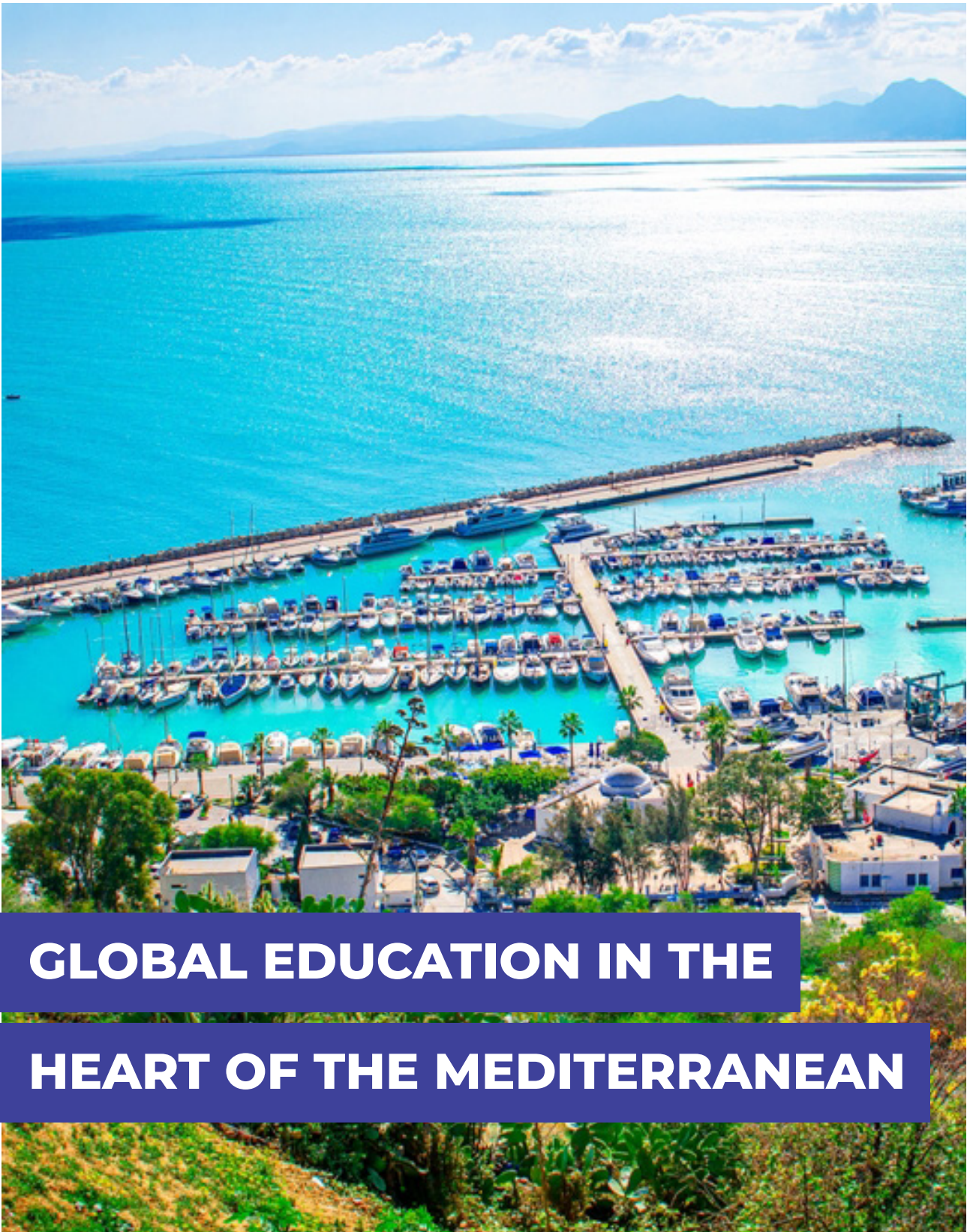




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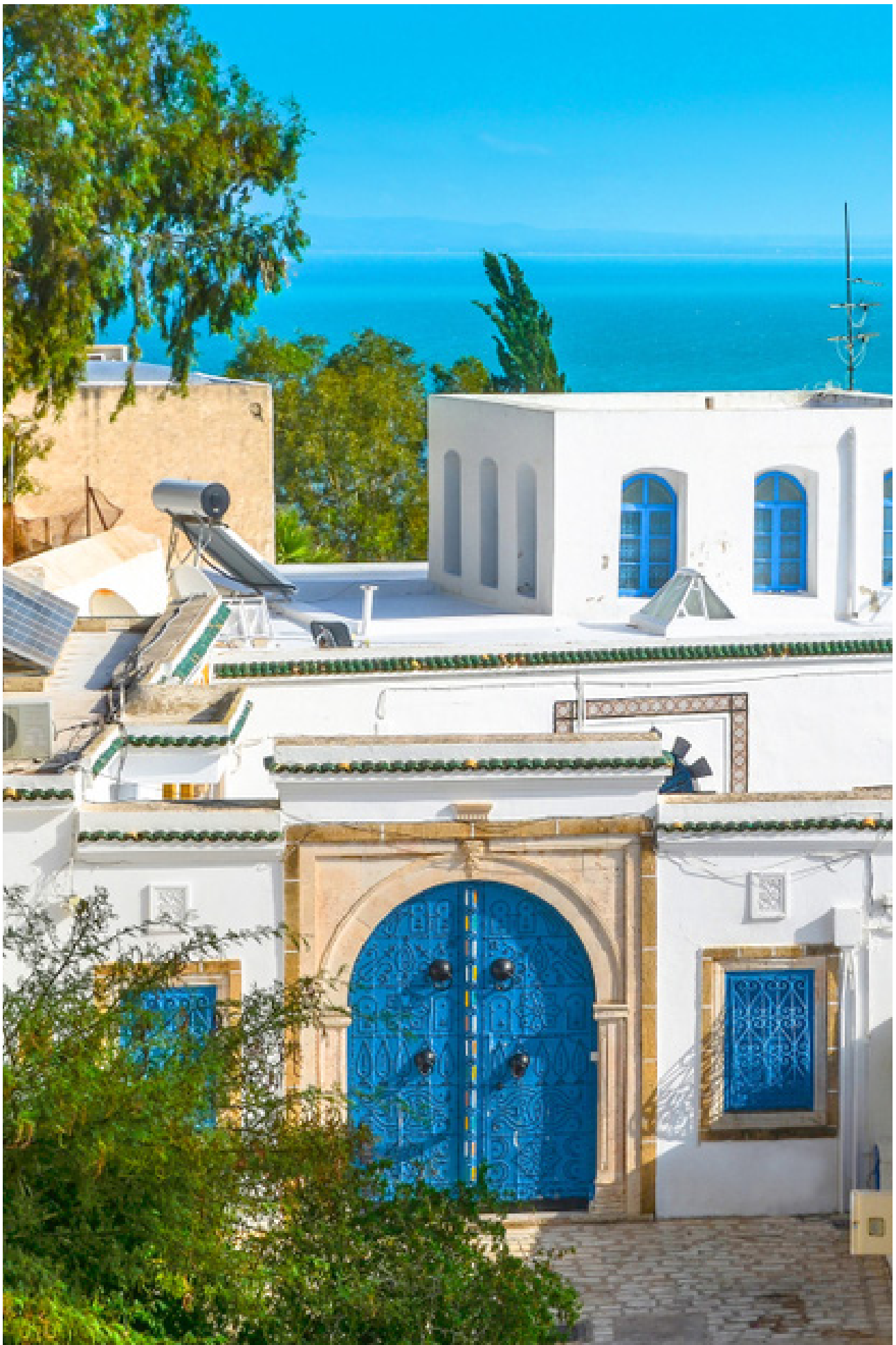

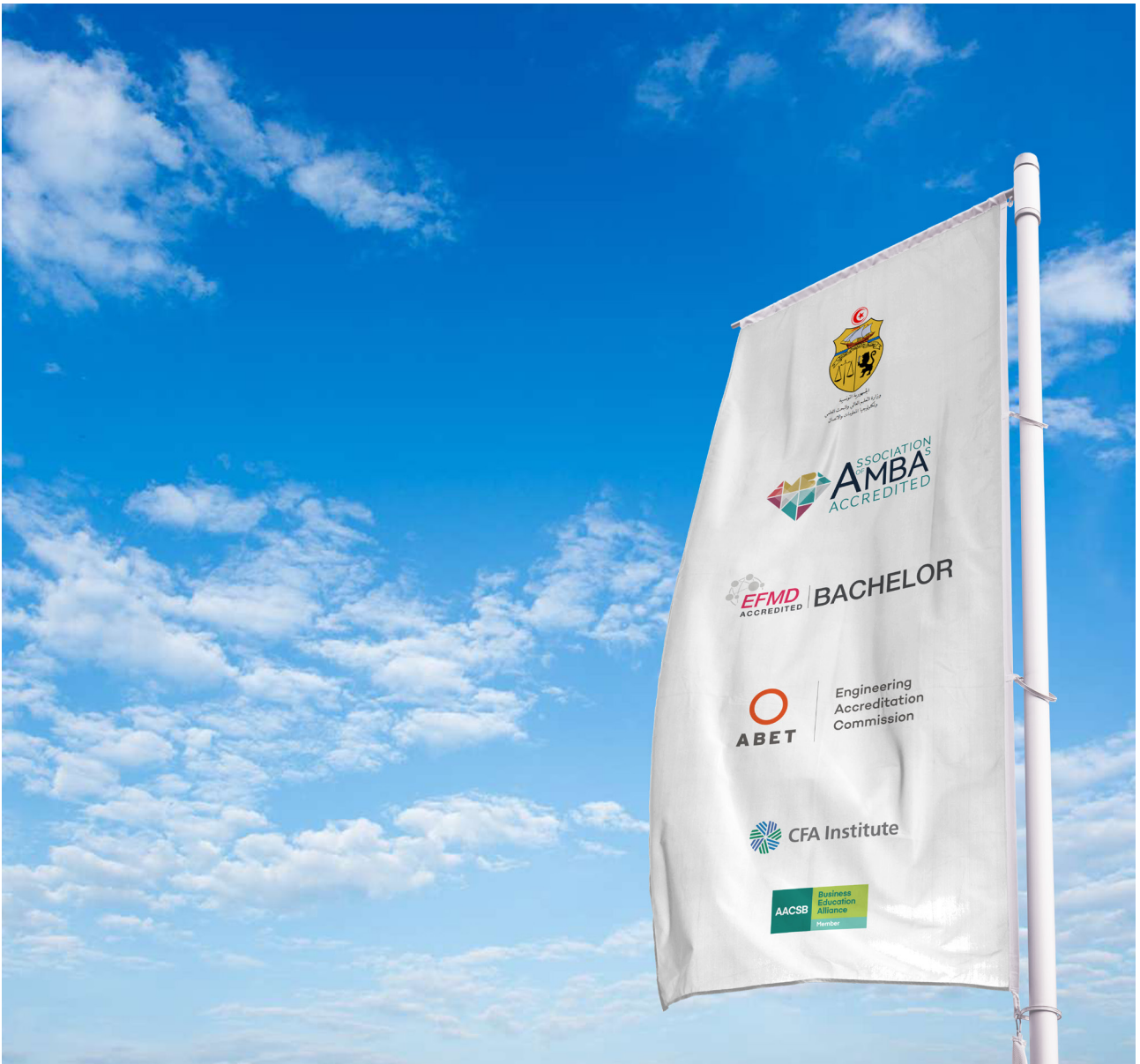


RENEWABLE ENERGY LAB

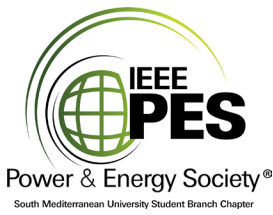

GETTING A BANK ACCOUNT

In order for you to open a bank account, you need the following documents:

- | A copy of your Residency card (Carte de Sejour)
- | A copy of your certificate of registration at SMU
- | A copy of the first page of your passport

REQUIREMENTS OF STUDENT ENTRY IN TUNISIA

Any foreign national intending to enter into Tunisia for purposes of study should:

- | Obtain a Tunisian visa (if applicable) to facilitate his /her entry into the country
- | Enter into Tunisia from and through only authorized ports of entry
- | Present a valid passport to the Immigration officer at the port of entry
- | Declare purpose of entry into Tunisia and the intended institution of training
- | Proceed to the designated immigration office after entry and obtain a residency card

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VISA ELIGIBILITY

The following criteria must be met.

- | A letter of acceptance must be provided demonstrating that an applicant has been offered a place on a full-time course of study at a recognized educational institution
- | Candidates must be able to demonstrate evidence of enough funds to support themselves in the country
- | It must be shown that the course fees have been paid in full
- | Private medical insurance must be arranged and documentary evidence of this must be provided
