Some nationalities will need to apply in advance for a Standard Visitor Visa. You cannot extend a visitor visa nor switch into a different visa category in the UK while on a Standard Visitor visa. Visa required depends on students' length of stay. Students nominated for Semester 1 only will not be able to extend their mobility to Full Academic Year. If you have any students that you are planning to nominate for Semester 1 only that might want to extend their stay, please inform both the Study Abroad team and relevant Faculty by 31st May 2023 as any extensions (from Semester 1 to Full Academic Year) will not be possible after this date.</p> <p>If the student has settled/pre settled status, the student is not required to have a visa to enter the UK.</p> |

| Attendance monitoring | <p>Please note: All students' attendance will be monitored, and all students on the Student Visa route will have attendance/engagement monitored by the International Student Compliance Team (ISC), to ensure they remain compliant with UKVI regulations and visa conditions.</p> <p>Please be aware that you cannot extend your study period (from one semester to full academic year) after your application is completed.</p> <p>For Incoming students: You will need to complete a 'Right to Study' check on arrival in the UK, before you can enrol on your course. This will be carried out by the ISC team who will contact you prior to enrolment to guide you through this process.</p> |
