Students coming to the Sheffield Business School – module rules

Students coming to the Sheffield Business School can choose modules from the following three Departments –

Management – Business modules Service Sector Management – Tourism, Hospitality & Events modules Finance, Accounting & Business Systems – Finance modules

Students must study 60 CATS (30 ECTS) or as close to this number of credits as possible. In most cases this means students picking **five** modules in total as most modules are 20 CATS (10 ECTS) each. The first three modules will form the study plan. The other two modules are reserve modules in case some modules do not run or there is a timetabling clash. Modules must be picked in order of preference and module choices cannot be altered post-application.

Here is some guidance on how to pick your modules-

When choosing your first three modules which will form your study plan, two modules must be from the same Department. So as an example, you can pick two Management modules and then compliment those with a Finance module.

When you choose your reserve modules, you must ensure they are from the same Department as the two main modules above.
