Studying in North Carolina


North Carolina is home to the Outer Banks beaches on the east coast and the Great Smokey Mountains in the western part of the state.

The academic experience

Higher education in the United States is known for its holistic approach focusing on academic, social and professional development.

Students will be registered full-time, a minimum of 12 US credits for undergraduate (approximately 4 classes) and 9 US credits for graduate (approximately 3 classes).

The faculty to student ratio is 19:1. All professors have open office hours each week during which you can visit to ask questions or for additional support.

Students are welcome to take any class for which they meet the pre-requisites.

- Supplemental documentation is required for engineering, computer science, music, dance, theatre and art.
- The following subject areas do not allow exchange students to take part in their classes: medical, dental, nursing, clinical lab sciences, and athletic training.
- Entrance to graduate programs will require permission from the corresponding department which may require supplemental documents to be reviewed.

How to join #PirateNation for Exchange

Program Eligibility

- Students must be nominated by the home university
- Students must supply a transcript from their home university in English
- Students must meet English proficiency requirements
 - » Duolingo English Test: 95
 - » IELTS: 6.0
 - » TOEFL: 71
 - » Exceptions for natives of English-speaking countries or programs instructed 100% in English

Costs

- Students pay tuition fees to their home university
- Students pay for housing and a meal plan at ECU
- Estimated \$7,750 USD per semester
