Nomination and Application Information	
Nomination Process	All students must be nominated by their home university. Nominations must be submitted via the online form: https://kent.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_bvbSQjKeWxT44hE .
Nomination Deadline	Fall Semester or Academic Year: March 1 Spring Semester: September 15
Application Process	After being nominated, students must complete an online application and submit supplemental forms. A checklist of steps to complete will be provided to the students once they are nominated.
Application Deadline	Fall Semester or Academic Year: April 1 Spring Semester: October 15
Acceptance and Visa	A student visa will be required for all students if they do not hold US citizenship. Upon admission to Kent State University, students will receive an admissions letter and their immigration document.

Course Requirement per Semester	<p>Undergraduate Students: minimum 12 US credit hours and maximum 18 US credit hours</p> <p>Graduate Students: minimum 8 US credit hours and maximum 18 US credit hours (please consult with departmental coordinator on recommended course load)</p> <p>If students enroll in more than the maximum number of credit hours, then they will be responsible for paying the per-credit hour tuition fee.</p>
Available Courses	<p>Please use the public course search to view the schedule of courses for each semester. Not all courses are available to international exchange or fee-paying students. Students must meet the pre-requisite requirements for all courses they intend to take.</p> <p>Please note that some programs are not available at the Kent Campus or are permissible for international exchange or fee-paying students.</p>

Tuition & Course Fees	<p>Exchange Students: Tuition is waived per the exchange agreement, but students may incur additional course fees for which they are responsible for paying (i.e., lab fees, studio fees, etc.).</p> <p>Fee-Paying Students: Tuition is updated each summer for the upcoming academic year. Please consult the Bursar's website for the current tuition rates.</p>
On-Campus Housing	Housing fees will vary depending upon the housing option selected by the student. Please consult the University Housing website for current rates.
Meal Plan	Meal plan fees will vary depending upon the option selected by the student. Please consult University Culinary Services website for current meal plan rates.
Student Health Insurance Plan	<p>Student Health Insurance Plan is required for all exchange and fee-paying students and cannot be waived.</p> <p>Fall 2022 Semester Only rate: \$1,382</p> <p>Academic Year 2022-2023 rate: \$2,888</p> <p>Spring Semester 2023 Only rate: \$1,742</p>
International Student Activity Fee	This fee is \$20 per semester and is required <i>for all international students</i> , as it supports delivery of international student services, events and activities.
Arts Fee	This fee is \$15 per semester and is required <i>for all undergraduate students</i> for free admission to theatre, music, orchestra, opera, dance, etc. events.
Career Services Fee	This fee is \$79.80 per semester and is required <i>for all undergraduate students</i> , as it provides access to student and alumni online career resources, networking, mentoring programs, workshops, career assessment, etc.
Early Arrival and Winter Break Housing	If students need to arrive before the housing contract period begins or live on campus during winter break, they must apply for Seasonal Break Housing and will be charged \$35 per night to their KSU Bursar account.
Personal Expenses	Students should budget for personal expenses, including bedding and towels (if planning to purchase upon arrival), toiletries, entertainment, etc.
