



The information on this page is provided for you and your family so that you will know approximately how much **Fall 2018 semester** (August 2018 – December 2018) will cost you, and when and how you may pay the required costs.

Shown below are the primary costs for your Fall 2018 semester at Methodist University.

Your **estimated actual charges** for the **Fall 2018** semester are \$7,500. However, in order to meet changing economic conditions, the Board of Trustees reserves the right to revise charges as conditions demand; but no changes will be made during a semester.

All international students are automatically provided with and charged for health insurance each semester. The fee for the insurance plan is added to the semester invoice, which is due and payable with the tuition and all other charges.

Additionally, most students require at least **\$100 per month** to meet their **personal expenses**.
