Requirements for unrestricted enrollment into degree program:


- TOEFL: 76+ iBT; IELTS: 6.5+
- Requirements for enrollment through the English Bridge Program:
- TOEFL: 57+ iBT; IELTS: 5.5+
- *SUNY Plattsburgh also accepts other tests of English proficiency.

All students must show proof of their English proficiency. Results from tests including TOEFL, iBT, IELTS, SAT, or ACT may be submitted as proof of English proficiency. There are no exceptions.
