#### **Incoming Student Quota**

Length of the study abroad/exchange period at Temple: one (1) year or one (1) semester

• Study Abroad: Typically, up to ten students from one institution at any given time

• Exchange: Typically 4 semesters per academic year (Fall-Spring)\*

#### Supplemental documents required:

- I-20 application (separate online application)
  - Financial documentation
  - Copy of biographical page of passport
- List of current semester courses
- Official language scores
- Course registration process form
- Official transcript(s)
- Housing deposit form (if applicable)

#### **Qualifications for Study Abroad and Exchange Students**

- Undergraduate (bachelor's) students: full-time enrollment at home university for at least 1 academic year
- Graduate (master's) students: students must receive approval by receiving department at Temple University
- GPA: approx. 3.00/4.00 or higher (80% or 3.5/4.5); Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA while enrolled at Temple.
- Official TOEFL (79 IBT, 550 paper-based), IELTS (6.0), or Duolingo English Test (110) scores\*
