Application Requirements

All applicants must be officially nominated by their home institution and complete all application components by stated deadlines. The nomination process will be emailed directly to exchange partners.

Proof of English Fluency

UTampa will accept a nomination by a partner institution as proof that the student fulfills the English language requirements and possesses the academic preparation to perform well in major-related coursework. However, students from institutions where English is not the primary language of instruction will need to present a letter from the institution proving fluency in English.

Application Portal

The first step in initiating the admissions process will be to submit your exchange application through the University of Tampa website. The application link is provided directly to nominated students.

Course Catalog

- Exchange students may select courses from any discipline but must possess knowledge of the subject matter of the course. The home institution is responsible for ensuring that students have met the necessary pre-requisites for the selected courses.
- Exchange students are allowed to take a maximum of one online course per semester.

Course Registration

- Students will be required to submit a pre-registration form and learning agreement both signed by their home institution.
- Business students can enroll in graduate level courses if they have pre-requisite knowledge and approval from host institution. Registration is granted on an individual basis upon space availability. Utampa graduate students have priority in these courses.

Course Restrictions

EMBA Classes:

This is a cohort-based program. Courses are only available to students enrolled in the EMBA Program.

Credit & Grading System

On average, courses are worth 4 US credits (8 ECTS credits) and grading is on a scale from A-F, where A is the best.

Transcripts

Students must order transcripts which will be issued within 5 weeks of the conclusion of the semester.

Housing

Double occupancy in on-campus housing. Bed, dresser, desk, bathroom sink, toilet and shower provided in each room. Linens and toiletries are not provided. On-campus housing is not guaranteed. **Graduate students must seek off-campus accommodation.**

Housing application deadlines:

Fall Semester: May 1

Spring Semester: October 15

Average Cost of Rent

On-campus housing ranges from **\$3,000-\$4800** per semester.

Off-campus housing ranges from **\$4,800-\$6,600** per semester.

Florida Climate

When selecting the University of Tampa as your host institution, please keep in mind that Florida temperatures can range from mid-70s to mid-90s Fahrenheit several months out of the year.

Immunizations

Visa Requirements

All students will be required to obtain a J-1 visa; UTampa will serve as your sponsor. The costs associated with the visa are \$220. You can pay your I-901 SEVIS fee at fmjfee.com. Save the receipt because you must present it to apply for your visa.

Student Health Insurance

Students are required to purchase insurance through the University of Tampa. Students will have access to the Health and Wellness Center on campus.
