International Exchange Students ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW: Pre-Arrival FAQ



FAQ:

Q: What documents do I need to bring when traveling?

A: Bring a copy of your VISA and check with your airline regarding other travel requirements.

Q: Do I need international insurance before traveling?

A: Yes, ensure you have suitable international insurance before traveling.

Q: When should I enter the UAE?

A: You must enter the UAE within 60 days from your VISA issuance date, approximately by 16th August.

Q: How long is my entry VISA valid for?

A: Your entry VISA is valid for 30 days.

Q: What is the total cost for the Student Visa process?

A: The total cost is AED 1,952, which includes Health Insurance, Entry Visa, Medical test, Emirates ID & Residency, and Cancellation fees.

Q: What do I need to submit for the residency procedure?

A: Submit your passport, 2 photographs (white background), AED 1,052, and an envelope labeled with your full name, UAE mobile number, and Student ID.

Q: How long does it take for the PR office to prepare my papers?

A: It takes 1-2 working days.

Q: What happens after I submit my papers?

A: You will need to complete a medical test, and you can join a free group trip to the medical center arranged by the OIAA in the first two weeks of classes.

Q: When will I receive my Emirates ID?

A: You will receive an SMS regarding its completion within 10 days. It will be sent to AU 2-3 days later, and you can pick it up from the Archive office (J2 Building, 1st Floor).

Q: Can I get an internship with my student visa?

A: Yes, the AU Center for Career and Professional Development offers you the opportunity to gain an unpaid internship during the registered semester. Inform the OIAA and your university if you want to have an internship at the beginning of the first semester.

Q: Can I work with my student visa?

A: No, you cannot work with this visa. You are only allowed to undertake an unpaid internship.

Q: What happens to my visa after the semester ends?

A: The PR office will cancel the visa by default after the semester ends, giving a 30-day warning before cancellation.
