NOTE

- Orientation session attendance is highly recommended to all international students.
- Semester dates may change according to unexpected academic or university activities; such will be informed to partners and students in advance.
- When booking flight tickets, students should consider spending at least a week in Ho Chi Minh City after the last exam date for any unexpected arrangement.



- English proficiency requirement: CEFR B2, IELTS 5.5 academic or equivalent.
- The application documents submitted must be in English only. If the original document is not in English, it is required to submit in both the copy of original version and the English translation with notarization by competent authorities of the sending country.

Admitted student will start receiving confirmation regarding his/her admission at HSU via e-mail.



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Hoa Sen University will send an Online Nomination Form to the coordinator at your home institution to officially nominate you as an exchange student before the deadline:

- Inbound Students Application
- Two passport-sized photos (4x6) (please scan and save as PNG/JPG)
- Copy of your passport (valid for the entire duration of your stay in Vietnam or at least 1 year from your expected arrival)
- Notarized or certified copies of degrees, diplomas, and academic transcripts (with English translations), applicable to your proposed study
- English Language Verification or a minimum proficiency equivalent to B2 CEFR (IELTS Academic 5.5 or TOEFL iBT 70 or higher)
- Medical examination certificate issued within the last 6 months, stating you are fit for overseas study
- Financial guarantee documents to support your study, research, and living expenses in Vietnam



HEALTH INSURANCE

The students **MUST** prepare comprehensive travel insurance and/or health insurance from their home country before arrival in Vietnam



VISA PROCESS

The entry and visa application will change according to the regulations at the time.



FEES APPLICABLE

- Admission fee: free of charge
- Visa fee: contact Vietnam Embassy at home country for updated tariff and procedure
- Living Cost: minimum **700 USD/month** (housing, transportation, meals, necessities)
- Study materials: free of charge, the students prepare the study materials and accessories by themselves

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

Vietnamese or English The university offers more than 400 courses in English Check the list of English course [HERE](#) for more details or Inbound SEP details [HERE](#).

REGISTRATION COURSES IN ENGLISH

- For each course, we open a class or many classes with different schedule (date, time, campus, and lecturer)
 - The SEP coordinator will contact students for class registration instruction one month before the semester starts. Students register for specific classes and check the schedule via university system; this important step takes place around a month prior to semester commencement date.
 - The university may cancel the classes with low registration rate and the students may need to register for replaced classes.

COURSE LOAD

- We are applying US credits and credit-based system in academic affair. The students have to go through registration/cancellation step a month prior to each semester.
- The home institution makes the credit conversion (e.g., to ECTS credit) based on course load. 6 ECTS is equivalent with 3 credits in Vietnamese Educational Credit System.
- Checking the course list to learn about the credits and session/semester for each course. Each session takes 50 minutes of class lecturer, without test or exam.

ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT

- The academic transcript is available at least three weeks after the final exam date.
- The home institution and the student will receive the academic transcript via email.
- The passing grading scale is from C+ to A+, i.e., 5 – 10 in 10 system for most of the courses.



IMPORTANT NOTES



- It is recommended to have no more than four international students per class.
- Each student may register for no more than five classes in total.
- Carefully check the campus location, the travel time between campuses, and the class schedule before making your selection to ensure feasibility.
- Ideally, select campuses located in the city centre for convenience.
- For certain courses in Tourism, Hospitality, Design, Media Production, and Management, students may be required to complete assessments such as field trips, video production, or modelling at their own expense. These courses often have class codes beginning with TO, HM, EM, RM, TK, or TT.
- Some courses have prerequisites that you may not have studied before. You should choose courses that match your major or for which you have sufficient background knowledge. If you need a detailed course description, please copy and send the Course Title and Course Code to the HSU Student Exchange Coordinator at ***nhu.tienngoc@hoasen.edu.vn***.
- At Hoa Sen University, 3 credits are equivalent to 6 ECTS in the European higher education system.
- Some courses are scheduled twice per week. For these, please enter only the first session into the registration form.
- Semester 1 (2026–2027) is scheduled to begin in mid-September 2026.
- In case classes are cancelled due to low enrolment, you will receive a list of cancelled classes and may add new courses to replace them.
- Please check and follow the class registration instructions sent by the contact person via email, approximately one month before the semester starts.
- Class registration operates on a first-come, first-served basis. Once a class is full, you will not be able to register. Register as soon as you are ready to secure your seat in your preferred classes.
